5. Unfinished & New Business

5.1 HUB Cycling Programs 2013 - Proposal Discussion

Russ Carmichael, Staff Liaison Maple Ridge informed the committee that there were no cycling programs requesting capital at this time in Maple Ridge for 2013. Mr. Carmichael is expecting a request to support a bicycle themed youth event for this spring break.

Ike de Boer, Engineering Services Coordinator for Pitt Meadows informed the committee that there have been no requests in Pitt Meadows for 2013.

5.2 Maple Ridge - Pitt Meadows Bikeways Plan

Ike de Boer, Staff Liason, Pitt Meadows, gave an overview of the Pedestrian and Cycling Master Plan and its recommendation to form a the bike and pedestrian Committee. Mr. de Boer explained that a new committee could be formed or the

existing Bicycle Advisory Committee could expand.

The Committee noted that if the Active Transportation Committee split into two separate community groups, they should meet at least twice per year to discuss common issues and connectivity between the communities.

The Committee discussed the further implications of expanding the existing BAC Committee to one 'Active Transportation Committee'.

The new Committee could include many different types of representatives including;

- Pedestrians
- Skateboarders
- Equestrian Supporters

Staff will discuss the possibilities of an active transportation committee in their representative departments before the next committee meeting.

5.3 Parking in Bike Lanes - follow up discussion

Russ Carmichael, Staff Liaison Maple Ridge, informed the committee that the area must be clearly marked for the bylaw to be enforced. Mr. Carmichael explained the Bylaws Department needs to be informed of the specific locations of the infractions in order to respond. He will follow up on the specific locations noted (121 between 216th and Laity)

5.4 Pitt Meadows Community Bike Ride Discussion

Peter Jongbloed, Community at Large in Pitt Meadows informed the Committee that he inquired about having a bike event on Pitt Meadows Day at Pitt Meadows Day Committee Meeting. Mr. Jongbloed advised the committee that there are too many obstacles for this event to take place on Pitt Meadows day, but he believes a separate bike event or events should be put together for both municipalities. Mr. Jongbloed also reminded the committee that the Bike Lock up will be taking place again this year at the Pitt Meadows Day event on June 1, 2013.

5.5 Lougheed Highway Multi-use Lane Open House

Russ Carmichael, Staff Liaison Maple Ridge, informed the Committee of an open house on February 21, 2013 at 3:00 pm to 8:00 pm the District of Maple Ridge is hosting to inform the public about the upcoming multiuse laneway project. Mr. Carmichael described the multiuse laneway to be on the north side of Lougheed Highway connecting 216th and Laity. Mr. Carmichael further explained that the funding for the multiuse laneway Lougheed Highway project would come 60% from a Provincial Grant, while the rest of the funding would come from Translink and the District of Maple Ridge. The idea for this connection originated with the

BAC at least 5 years ago as a Gap in infrastructure. It will provide a connection allowing cyclists to go from the Pitt River Bridge to 256th Street on a continuous designated bike route which includes dikes, residential subdivisions, on street bike lanes and separated pathways.
