Innovation Forum 2019: The 2<sup>nd</sup> Annual Innovation in Emerging Cities forum is scheduled to take place on Tuesday, April 2, 2019 at the ACT Arts Centre. An additional venue at the Greg Moore Youth Centre may offer a trade show and/or career fair. There may also be some smaller events taking place in advance of April 2 that will serve as prequels to the larger Innovation in Emerging Cities event.

The Innovation Task Force, a subgroup of the Economic Development Committee, is working on the details of the event. The Task Force will soon be seeking sponsors, panelists and speakers.

<u>Fraser Valley Tech Forum</u>: This forum is put on by SRCTEC and the Economic Development Department agreed to help promote the event as they will do the same for our Innovation Forum in April of 2019.

International Parking Day: This is a global initiative to promote re-thinking of public space. It takes place annually on the third Friday in September. The Planning Department, together with Economic Development and Parks, Recreation & Culture, will be working with local businesses along 224 Street to transform parking stalls and alleyways into mini park-like spaces for an afternoon.
