Council has provided a total of \$90,763 for 2018 towards festivals and special events. In the second intake of festival grant funding, the following three organizations received support: Maple Ridge Christmas Festival Society, Maple Ridge Pitt Meadows Recycling Society (Earth Day) and the Christmas Haven group.
