Fraser Valley Food Truck Festival and Rivers Day are all happening in the next few weeks. Enjoy these wonderful events organized by your neighbours.


## **INFORMED: 2018 Local Election**

### **Important Dates for the Upcoming Election**

On Saturday, October 20, citizens around BC will be going to the polls to elect their Mayors, Councillors and School Trustees. Here in Maple Ridge there will also be a separate ballot for a non-binding plebiscite on garbage and green waste curbside pickup. There are a number of important dates coming up, from the nomination deadline for candidates to the advance polls leading up to the October 20 General Election day.

This is just a reminder to bookmark the City of Maple Ridge election webpage **mapleridge.ca/306** so you are in the loop on the latest information on the upcoming election. In addition to the City website, please keep an eye out for important notices in The News and on the City's Facebook page.

This year the City will also be sending out a direct mailer to all homes and businesses. We want to make sure that all citizens have information on advance polling dates,
