On September 12, 1874 Maple Ridge became BC's sixth incorporated community, only seven short years after the Canadian Confederation. On Friday, September 12, 2014 we will celebrate our 140th Birthday with a FREE family concert in the park that will run from 5:00 pm until 9:30 pm. The bandstand will be called the 'Port Metro Vancouver Stage' in recognition of their financial support for the Birthday celebration. Entertainers represent the many talented musicians who live and work in our community. At 7:00 pm there will be a formal ceremony that will include local dignitaries and greetings from Ottawa and Victoria as well as a special drama presentation by members of the Emerald Pig Theatrical Society. Bring a blanket, sweater, lawn chair and the whole family for this wonderful outdoor concert.

In addition to the concert, you will be able to visit with members of the Operations and Engineering teams, the Maple Ridge Fire Department and the Ridge Meadows RCMP who will be on hand with vehicles they use to do their work in the community every day. It's a great opportunity to mingle with staff and volunteers plus get your photo taken in the various vehicles that will be on display. There will be souvenir handouts to mark this special Birthday.

The celebration continues on Saturday, September 13 starting at 9:00 am with the Haney Farmers Market at Memorial Peace Park. The market will celebrate the rich history of our community with a strong theme to the amazing food and agricultural legacy of Maple Ridge. The Maple Ridge Museum & Community Archives will have a wonderful display in the bandstand, and there will also be special displays by the Maple Ridge Downtown Business Improvement Association, local agriculture sector and the history of First Nations in the region. The displays and Farmers Market run until 2:00 pm.

Finally, the Birthday celebration ends at the Port Haney Wharf with a special Port Haney Days 'Movie on the Wharf' night organized by the Port Haney Neighbourhood Change team. You and your family are invited down to the Wharf to watch the sunset and then a presentation of 'Shark Tales' on the outdoor screen. This events starts at 7:00 pm and runs until the movie ends. 
Council Meeting Videos

If you're interested in running for Mayor, Council or School Trustee in the Maple Ridge Local Election this fall, then you may be interested in attending an informal information meeting. Join us on Monday, September 8, 2014 at 7:00 pm in Council Chambers at Municipal Hall.

Senior staff from both Maple Ridge and School District No. 42 will be on hand to answer your questions and provide background information on some recent changes to the election reporting requirements, the four year term and what's involved in being an elected official. This is a great way for you and key members of your campaign team to get the facts on how you become a candidate and the requirements for keeping records of campaign finances. Current Council members and School Trustees are encouraged to attend and share their experiences as an elected official.

Across BC citizens will be electing their Mayors, Council and School Trustees on Saturday, November 15, 2014. In the 2011 election Maple Ridge's voter turnout was just over 25%, with 12,809 citizens casting a vote.
