




- ***Aligning*** the vision and work-plan of the Community Heritage Commission with the heritage policies in the Maple Ridge Official Community Plan;

Maple Ridge Museum and Community Archives continues to outstrip its room to grow...

New to the Collection! ***Maple Ridge Recycling Society Fonds.***

Object collection:

- 15,000 individual items – around 400 too big for boxes with 150 very large/heavy items

Archival collection:

- 13,700 indexed and scanned photographs and at least 250,000 negatives with no scans or prints.
- 200 document collections [archives fonds] with 3,500 folders.
- 140 large folders of oversized plans and maps
- 95 very large maps rolled and stored
- Gazette newspapers – 1923 to 1980
- *Maple Ridge Pitt Meadows Times* – film-based images 1985 to roughly 2002.




