

Site Requirements for Vendors/Participants in Festivals and Events



VEHICLE LOAD IN/LOAD OUT:

- The loading zones are for 10 MINUTES ONLY unload your vehicle, move your vehicle, then set up your tent/display area.
- Vendors/Event Participants are to follow Event Organizer's Directions.
- The One Way only circular roadway in the park is a FIRE LANE. It cannot be blocked by vehicles or tents during set up, event duration, or post event.
- Event Organizers will use cones to mark off the Fire lanes and loading zones are identified on the map. (see park map on reverse)

Stagger Setup: If there are multiple events or many vendors sharing the site, an unloading plan will include staggered arrivals to reduce congestion.

- Event organizers will supervise to ensure quick removal of vehicles.
- Vendors will bring adequate personnel to unload and to stay with equipment while the vehicle is relocated.

PARK GUIDELINES

- Spiking not permitted in the park. Vendors and participants must use portable weights (tent weights, water buckets, sand bags) that are sufficient for the site/weather.
- All food services must have an approved fire extinguisher on site (5lb minimum).
- There are two grey water disposal sites, on located on the west and one located on the east end of the park, these are the only locations where grey water can be disposed of. (See Map)



PARKING ACCESS:



Parking is available below Memorial Peace Park, accessed from Dewdney Trunk Road or 224 Street or Edge Street. Parking access is limited to vehicles 6'6
 Cost: First hour is Free, then 75 cents per hour, to a maximum of \$4 per day. Regardless of length of stay, you must register the stall number that you vehicle is in using the parking machines located at each main entrance.
