Edmund Pope: The Citizen Timeline





26 March 1866

Edmund Pope is born in Cornwall, England



17 March 1887

Marriage of Mr. Edmund Pope of Keneggy Breage to Miss Eleanor Laity of Marazion, in the Register-Office of Penzance



14 September 1887

Edith Pope is born in Helston, Cornwall, England

> Eleanor and Edith Pope emigrate from England to Canada—joining Edmund. We think Edmund is a fruit grower or farmer.







Edmund Pope takes on a lot of small jobs for Maple Ridge.

6 June 1891

First mention of Edmund Pope in the Council Minutes of Maple Ridge.

E. Pope Pathmaster for Ward No. 4

Type of Pathmaster work:

cleaning up tail ditch and cutting logs \$10; removing 2 large stumps \$4.75; ditching on River Road \$10.80; work performed on the paths and at the cemetery.

Edmund undertakes road work at various locations in the community

1903 Raise of salary from \$8 to \$20 per year. 1926 Appointed at a retaining fee of \$100 per year.

Edmund nurses James Ward and is reimbursed for expenses

Ancient Order of United Workmen

The organization was a breakaway from the Masonic Order

The AOUW evolved into a Life Insurance Company.

29 May 1905

Due to resignation of J. Irving, Edmund appointed as Pathmaster Beat 10.

Edmund died at Royal Columbian Hospital, New Westminster of carcinoma of the left kidney. Edmund 78 years, 4 months, 7 days at death.



5 August **1944**

Community Policing Update - Partners In Policing

Policing in Ridge-Meadows: 1890-1998

As 1998 and the 125th anniversary year of the RCMP near a close, it seems like an opportune time to take a look at the history of our own Ridge-Meadows Detachment.




Edwin Pope, the district's first police officer.

1890-1920: Chief Const. Edwin Pope was a one-man police force. The police station was located on the upper floor of the municipal hall on Calligan Ave. In addition to being the Chief Constable, at various time he also performed the tasks of sanitary inspector, licence and tax collector, pound keeper and fire marshall.

1922: Part-time constables begin to serve various parts of Maple Ridge. Police Department acquires its first vehicle - a Model T Ford.

1936: B.C. Provincial Police take over policing in Maple Ridge.



1944: Two police officers work through World War II.

1948: Police Department acquires its first separate police building near 224 Street. In 1951, this building was incorporated into the north end of the second municipal hall. After using an office in the old municipal hall in the early days, the local police got their own police station in 1948.

1948: FM police radios installed in police cars

1950: Royal Canadian Mounted Police replace B.C. Provincial Police in Maple Ridge.

- RCMP Detachment moves into the Public Safety Building on Dewdney Trunk Road.
