This proposed 2017 capital improvement project includes a new park access, additional parking and a new lit synthetic turf field to replace the existing lit, gravel all-weather field.

#### **NEIGHBOURHOOD CONTEXT**


Merkley Park shares a combined site with Maple Ridge Secondary School.
