

HAMMOND DOG OFF-LEASH AREA

The construction of the dog off-leash area is complete and includes a large dog and small dog area, a gravel pathway and picnic tables.

JUNE 2018 - CONSTRUCTION

Construction of the City of Maple Ridge's newest dog off-leash area reached the final stages in June 2018. This new dog off-leash area is located under the Golden Ears Bridge at the end of Wharf Street in Hammond. A fenced area has been installed. A gravel pathway in the large dog area gives owners/handlers a chance to walk, while their dog runs around. Picnic tables, signs and garbage container are available. Come and check it out!

SPRING 2018 - CONSTRUCTION

The majority of the new off-leash area was constructed in Spring of 2018.

JANUARY - FEBRUARY 2018 - PUBLIC FEEDBACK

The online comment period was available from January 22 to February 12, 2018.

2017 - CONCEPT DEVELOPMENT

The preliminary concept plan was developed for discussion with Translink. The concept plan included a common gravel entry way into a separated small dog area or large dog area. The area will be enclosed with a farm style wire fence.

The Golden Ears Bridge Dog Off-Leash Area is proposed under the Golden Ears Bridge and will include separated areas for larger dogs and small dogs. The concept plan was developed in discussion with Translink.
