ROTARY FIELD SRT

AUGUST 2018 - COMPLETION

The new shock pad underlay, synthetic turf carpet and infill installation was completed over the summer and finished before Community football's season opener, the 'Knights of the Round Table' tournament, in August. The City has moved to a new infill product, thermoplastic elastomer, which is a specially engineered odourless product made from virgin material which offers cooler surface temperatures and excellent sports performance.

SUMMER 2018 - FIELD REPLACEMENT

The civil work associated with the resurfacing includes the removal and recycling of the synthetic field components, carpet and infill, along with the field base relevelling. The SRT field has experienced some settlement, likely due to being constructed on a partially filled area, resulting in the need for additional civil work to address this issue.

Rotary field at SRT will be replaced with an alternative infill material, the same as what will be installed at Arthur Peake Centre field. Until recently, recycled crumb rubber infill has been used as other options with proven performance for sports surfaces have not been available.

Now with new and greener synthetic turf infill products available, alternate infills are becoming more widely used.

MAY 2018 - FENCE REPLACEMENT

The backstop fencing surrounding the field will be replaced with a thicker gauge chain-link mesh.
