2020 Property Tax Deadline Extended to September 30



While the due date for tax payments is still today, Thursday, July 2, your Council recognizes that the COVID-19 pandemic has impacted household finances and have **extended the penalty free deadline to September 30, 2020**, to provide some extra time to allow citizens to stabilize their financial situation. We would like to thank everyone who was able to make their payment as part of the normal deadline and for their patience as we deal with the challenges of the COVID-19 pandemic.

While the penalty free payment date is September 30, 2020, you can make your payment any time using a variety of methods. The full selection of options is outlined on the back of your 2020

Property Tax Notice. From using online banking to dropping your payment off at the City Drop Box, remember that you need to claim your Home Owners Grant.

You can access your account online at **hog.mapleridge.ca** and follow the link to your account. Your folio number and access code (PID) are on your tax notice. You can access you Tax Notice anytime on your 'MyCity' account using the eSERVICES link on the home page at **mapleridge.ca**.

For those who have made their annual payment, you may want to consider signing up for the Pre-Authorized Withdrawal Service (PAWS) which provides citizens with the option of paying taxes in ten monthly withdrawals. Go to *mapleridge.ca/2325* for more information on the PAWS option.

Recreation Programming & Facilities Are Reopening





On Monday, June 22 the City of Maple Ridge launched a new job application system - VidCruiter. This new careers portal has enhanced and improved features, making it easier for potential team members to apply for jobs with the City. You can find more information online at *mapleridge.ca/2035*.

Applicants will be required to create a new profile using their email address. Job applicants will also need to upload their resume the first time they apply for a job using the new portal. Please note: if you have applied for a job with us in using our previous job application system your profile will not be copied over. Any current job applications are accounted for and will remain in progress. Applicants selected to move forward will be contacted as normal.

The last few months have been difficult and many of you have been waiting to receive updates on positions you have applied for. We will be reviewing our current recruitments and making decisions respecting which recruitments will continue to move forward and those we hope to repost at a future date.
