On Monday, July 1 we are putting on a Canada day celebration that will give you an opportunity to show your Canadian pride through your attire, your unabashed flag waving and by singing our national anthem like they do at the Canucks games – loud and proud!

The festivities will take place at Memorial Peace Park and the day will begin with the Haney Farmers Market in their usual spot at the west side of the bandstand. This year, music and official ceremonies will take place on the stage in front of the Arts Centre Theatre on the east side of the park.

Everything kicks off at 10:00 am and the official flag ceremony and speeches will be at 12:30 pm. 

INFORMED: Taxes are Due July 2!

Avoid the Lines by Using Online Tools!



The clock is ticking and this Tuesday, July 2 is the deadline to pay your 2013 property taxes. Thousands of your neighbours have discovered how to avoid lining up by using the large number of online tools available.

We introduced a number of new online services to help eliminate the need to line up. New for 2013 is the ability to view Property Tax Notices Online using the 'My Maple Ridge' portal. Starting in 2014, you will be able to get your property tax notice electronically.

Also new for 2013 is the ability to pay your taxes by credit card. A third party service provider, PAYMENTUS, will take your payment and charge a 3% service fee above the amount of your Property Tax Bill. We've also enhanced our Pre-Authorized

Withdrawal System (PAWS) to provide citizens with the opportunity to pre-pay their taxes with 10 installments or to have an automatic withdrawal of the full amount on the tax due date.

Finally, the ability to claim your HOME OWNER GRANT online, combined with the fact that you can pay your Property Taxes at your financial institution or using most online banking programs eliminates the need to stop by Municipal Hall. If you do choose to line up, we will process your payment as quickly as possible. You have the option of using the drop off box located outside Municipal Hall at the west entrance. All payments must be received by **midnight, Tuesday, July 2, 2013.**
