A postcard was included in June's property tax mailer reminding you of the local election taking place on Saturday, October 15, 2022. Citizens will have the opportunity to cast their vote to elect Mayor, Councillors and School Trustees that will serve our community for the next four years.

In the coming weeks you will see advertising and social media posts about the upcoming election. Advance voting opportunities have been expanded and will include October 1, 5, 8, 11, 12, and 13 as well as mail ballot and drive thru voting opportunities.

A voter information flyer detailing important information on where and when you can cast your vote will be mailed in September. On Election Day there will be various polling locations around the neighbourhood to make it convenient for everyone to cast their vote.
